What we have been up to this week in UKS2

Year 5: In Maths this week we have been learning about factors and multiples. We have also been practicing our square and cubed numbers which we should continue to practice at home.

In Literacy we have been planning and writing our own short stories based on 'Street Child'. Our target has been to use a range of punctuation in our writing and to begin to vary our sentence structures.

<u>Year 6:</u> This week in Maths we have been concentrating on answering questions involving negative numbers. Children have also been practicing their arithmetic skills making sure they are confident in the formal written methods of addition and subtraction. Our more able students have been challenged to calculate difficult questions mentally using a variety of techniques.

In Literacy we have been looking at newspapers and identifying the features of journalistic writing. Children have planned their own news report based on the Macmillan Coffee Morning.
