



What we have been up to this week in LKS2

In LKS2 we have been completing our science assessments about states of matter (Year 4) and forces and magnets (Year 3). We have been getting in to the Christmas spirit and really enjoyed watching the dress rehearsal of the Reception Nativity. The French Market Enterprise Day was a huge success and all classes loved selling their own products. A fantastic effort from everyone!

Year 3: In Maths we have learned how to calculate unit fractions and non-unit fractions of given amounts. We have also learned how to tell the time on both analogue and digital clocks and have solved a range of word problems associated with fractions and time. In Literacy we have read and discussed a range of poems and have studied alliteration, rhyme and descriptive vocabulary. We have used this knowledge to generate our own rhyming couplets and poems.

Year 4: In Maths we completed our learning about time and we have moved on to money. We have been learning about decimal notation, how to make mounts of money and we have been attempting some tricky word problems. In Literacy, we have been learning about persuasive writing. We have looked at repetition, superlatives, rhetorical questions and also emotive language. We have had a class debate and also written a short persuasive text on a topic of our choice.
