



What we have been up to this week in LKS2

Year 3: It has been a fun and busy week in Year 3. In Maths we have measured and compared the length and mass of various objects and have added/subtracted different units of measure. In English, we have looked at a range of explanation texts and have discussed their range of features. The children will soon be planning and writing their own explanation text. We have also started our new science topic: Rocks and Soils.

Year 4: In year 4 this week we have continued learning about fractions. We have learned how to add and subtract fractions and we have become experts at finding fractions of amounts and equivalent fractions. In English we have been looking at instructions and have started to read our new class novel, 'How to Train your Dragon'. In Science we started our new sound topic and enjoyed walking around our school and going on a sound hunt.
