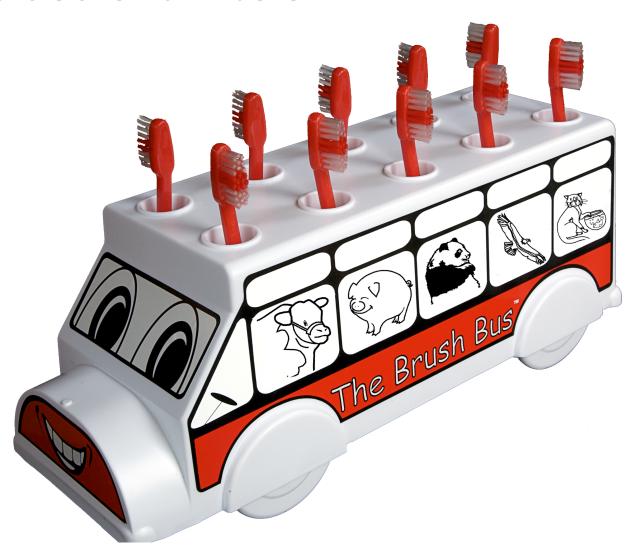


We're using the

What is the Brush Bus?

To improve dental health in Manchester, children will be brushing their teeth at nurseries, children's centres and childminders as well as at home with you.

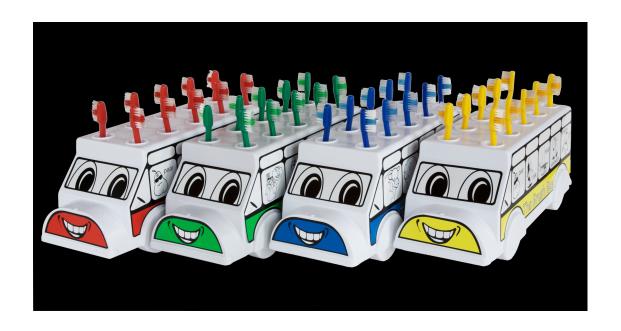
Each child will be given their own labelled toothbrush.

The toothbrushes will be stored hygienically in the Brush Bus.

Toothbrushes and family fluoride toothpaste will be kept at the centre.



Your child will be supervised while they brush their teeth daily at the nursery, children's centre or childminder's.



Brushing advice



Stay with your child to help them when they brush.



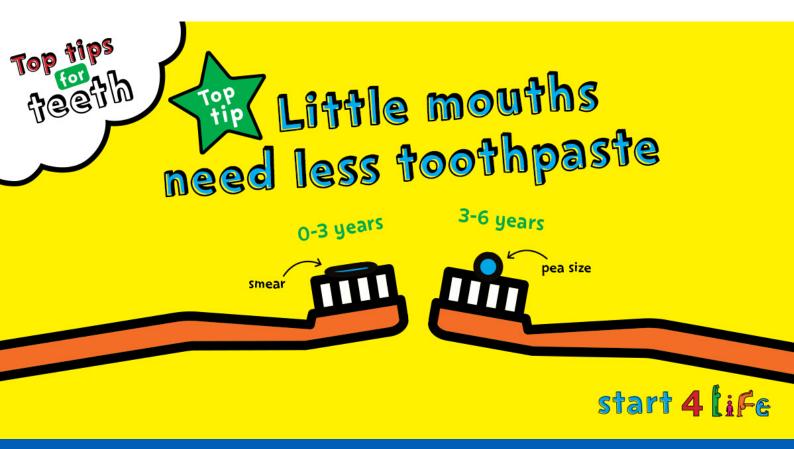
It is very important that parents make sure their childreń brush their teeth at home every morning and last thing at night. Use just a little fluoride toothpaste.



Children over 3 years old should spit out the toothpaste but not rinse their mouth out with water.



Using fluoride toothpaste reduces dental decay.
