



## What we have been up to in LKS2

Year 3: In Maths, we have subtracted numbers using the formal written method and rounded numbers to the nearest 10 and 100 in order to estimate calculations.

In English we have been learning about instruction texts, imperative verbs and fronted adverbials. We will use this learning to write our own instruction texts next week.

We started our new science topic on light and reflection. We now know various sources of light and how we need light in order to see various objects.

Year 4: In Maths, we have revised place value and rounded numbers to 10, 100 and 100. We have also added and subtracted 10, 100 and 1000 to numbers.

In English we have been learning all about the setting of an Indian jungle and have explored the five senses. We used this planning to complete our assessed write of a description of a jungle setting.

We also started a new Science topic (Electricity) and explored the hazards that are associated with electricity. We now know how to stay safe when using electricity. Why not ask us for advice?!
