What pupils say?

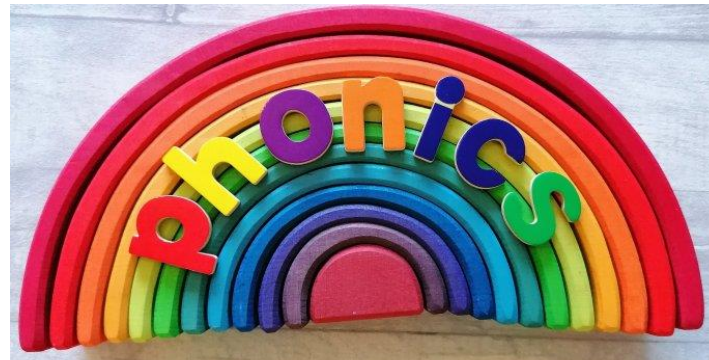
I like writing sounds in shaving foam - Arc
