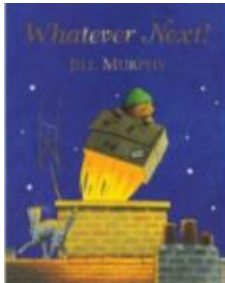

First Hand / Real Life Learning Experiences

UW – Working Scientifically / Geographical Development

- Videos of rocket launches
- Videos and photos of the Earth from space
- Pictures of rockets, photos from when rocket visited Pike Fold
- FX video of satellite crashing to Earth
- Small World- Rocket and space
- Role Play- Rocket launch control

UW – Working Scientifically

- Make star telescopes out of kitchen roll tubes and sticky stars.
- Talk about the names of different planets and what they look like.
- Bubbling Planets experiment
- Use a keyboard to write on editable space rockets
- Explore light and dark using torches and cardboard boxes
- Talk about the different shapes of the Moon
- Going to the dark room in the ARC
- Space activity in the sensory room

CL

- Beginning to understand why and how questions.
- Is able to follow directions
- Use longer sentences of four to six words
- Builds up vocabulary that reflects a breadth of their experience.
- Two- channeled attention- can listen and do for a short span..
- Links statements and sticks to the main theme or intention.
- Follow instructions involving several ideas.
- Develop their own narratives and explanations by connecting ideas.
- Listen to and talk about selected non-fiction to develop a deep familiarity with new knowledge and vocabulary.
