

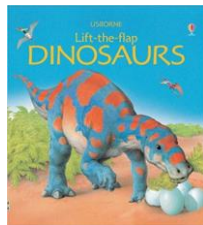

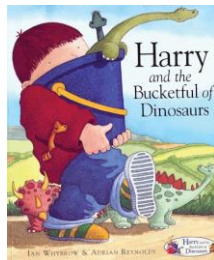

Investigate herbivores and carnivores and how they are similar and different.

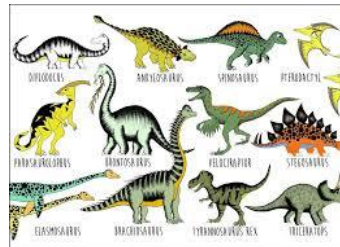
Video clips of different types of Dinosaurs
