



What did dinosaurs eat? Why did they have different teeth? What happened to the dinosaurs? What is your favourite dinosaur? How do we know about dinosaurs? What would it be like if dinosaurs lived today? What different sounds do Dinosaurs make?



#### **EAD** / Art Processes and Techniques

Dinosaur printing using potato prints. Use clay/salt dough to create dinosaur fossils. Make a dinosaur fossil picture out of straws. Create a stick puppet dinosaur. Design and colour in a dinosaur mask. Silhouette dinosaur pictures.
