



#### What we have been up to this week in LKS2

# Across our key stage, this week, we have been completing assessments in maths, reading and SPaG. These assessments will help to set individual targets for the children and essentially help the children to lead their own learning.

<u>Year 3</u>: This week in year 3 we have been focusing on place value in maths. We have been doing lots of practical activities to familiarise ourselves with the value of digits in 3 digit numbers. We have also been learning about the stone age in our theme lessons.

<u>Year 4</u>: This week in maths we have been looking at place value in 4 digit numbers. In literacy we have started our novel study of Beowulf. We have been learning lots of new vocabulary and applying this to our writing, as well as learning about fronted adverbials and noun phrases.

In Science we started our new topic 'States of Matter'. We are going to be leanring all about solids, liquids and gases and what they are made up of. In RE we started our new Hinduism topic and in French we learned some classroom instructions and started to look at classroom objects. Why not ask pupils to demonstrate their fabulous French accents!?
