



What we have been up to this week in LKS2

<u>Year 3</u>: This week in Year 3 we have been focusing on formal written methods of column addition and subtraction. In English, we have been learning about The Bronze and Iron Age and how they compare to earlier periods, such as The Stone Age. In Art we have been learning about Claude Monet and we have been practicing our 4 and 8 times tables.

We have also celebrated the British values of liberty and mutual respect, showing an understanding of how these exist in modern society and how we practise them in our lives.

<u>Year 4:</u> In maths we have been learning formal methods of addition and subtraction and we have been consolidating this learning by completing word problems. In English, we have been learning about newspapers. We have looked at the features and explored various articles. We have also identified the 5w's from texts to prepare us for writing our own newspaper article.

We have also started learning about mapping, as part of our new topic. We have sketched maps, explored ordnance survey maps and learned about map symbols. On Thursday, 4P visited Pizza Express and made our own pizzas to enhance our learning about healthy bodies. 4F will be visiting in the new year.
