Year 3: It has been a fun and exciting week in Year 3. In Maths we have recognised and described 2D and 3D shapes and in English we have written transcripts of news reports. The pupils demonstrated a good understanding of subordinate clauses and have tried to include them in their writing. In Science we have moved on from the study of various rocks and are beginning to understand how fossils are formed.

Year 4: In maths this week we have been learning about statistics. We have looked at bar graphs and line graphs and interpreted the information in them. We have drawn our own from a given set of data and we have also practised our 8 times tables. In English we have started to research and write a non chronological report about a dragon, unicorn or mermaid. We have been including some amazing complex sentences.
