## What we have been up to in LKS2

Year 3: In Maths we have been working a lot with money. We have explored different ways you can make an amount and have learned how to add and subtract money values (using decimal points). We have also calculated the total cost of various items in our very own 'Cave Man Shop'. After purchasing a range of items we worked out the change given.

In English we have written our own set of instructions of how to make pancakes, including important features such as time connectives, powerful imperative verbs and fronted adverbials.

In Science we have learned how light reflects off surfaces and into our eyes and have discussed what materials are best suited for reflection. We used this understanding to design a retroreflective book bag to help keep us safe in the dark.

**Year 4:** In Maths we have been learning about fractions of shapes and amounts and equivalent fractions. We used real pizza to identify real fractions and discussed why each piece has to be exactly the same size.

In English we have been learning the story of Anansi and the Turtle. We have acted out the story, explored the characters and built the setting using lego to help us write setting descriptions.

In Science we have been learning more about electricity and circuits. We have learned about switches and what a basic circuit needs to work. We also took part in science mix up afternoon, which we all really enjoyed
