



## What we have been up to in LKS2

**Year 3:** In Maths we have used multiplication methods to solve a range of word problems. We have also solved missing number problems using inverse calculations. In English we have learned about various aspects of SPaG, such as possessive apostrophes for singular and plural nouns, apostrophes for contracting words and spelling words that are commonly misspelt. In RE we have learned how Christians celebrate Lent and in Science we are beginning to understand how shadows are formed around objects.

Year 4: In Maths we have taken part in outdoor learning to consolidate our learning of the four operations. Why not give us a maths story to complete and we will wow you with our knowledge!? In English we have learned more about the use of fronted adverbials and worked together to create amazing sentences. We have also learned about using an apostrophe with plural nouns. In Science we have learned how electricity travels from its source to our house.

LKS2 watched a theatre production of 'A Little Princess' and took part in an exciting workshop about acting, stage mechanics and use of props. Ducks have been hatching all around the school so keep an eye on Class Dojo for updates on their progress!
