Our current topic is 'Minibeasts' and the children have loved their first week of learning. On Monday the Nursery children went on a bug hunt at forest school and found all sorts of little creatures! Nursery have been busy making minibeasts from different shapes such as squares, circles, rectangles, triangles and ovals.
