What we have been up to in LKS2

Year 3: This week in Year 3 we have been adding and subtracting amounts of money and we have learned how to use nouns and pronouns appropriately. On Thursday, both Year 3 classes went to Lyme Park in Cheshire. We learned about the history of the house and local area and reinforced our mapping skills. Ask us questions about compass points and map symbols to test our knowledge.

Year 4: This week in year 4 we have been learning all about our new topic: Ancient Egypt. We have painted hyroglyphs on papyrus, made our own 3D fact pyramids, explored Egyptian Gods, carried out an investigation about Tutankhamen and learned about the geography of Egypt and the importance of the River Nile.

All classes celebrated a new scheme across the school: Times Table Rockstars. The children looked absolutely fantastic in their costumes and they can't wait to practise their times tables and become a Rock Legend.
