



What we have been up to this week in LKS2

<u>Year 3</u>

In Year 3 in Maths we have been measuring objects in millimetres, centimetres and metres. We have also been converting amounts between different units of measurement and ordering the lengths from shortest to largest. After designing our photo frames last week we have been creating them using polystyrene and decorating them. In English we have written our draft explanation texts on how fossils are formed, edited and improved them and completed out final piece.

Year 4

This week in Maths we have used number lines to calculate change and completed two step money problems. In English we wrote a character description of Grendel from our class book, Beowulf. In our theme lesson we learned about Anglo Saxon food and in PSHE we created our own videos to promote being a responsible online citizen.
