### Supporting parents to read with their children at home.

Videos sent to parents of teachers teaching phonics games so they can play them at home. Video of a guided reading session to help them to know what to ask when reading the books that are sent home.

**Small cosy reading area** for children to enjoy reading - the reading display is also being developed with photos of our current children enjoying books.

**Incorporate books in maths lessons** e.g "the doorbell rang", "grandpas quilt" etc.
