During the coming weeks, children will be using afternoon sessions to catch-up on any key learning from the previous year they may have missed during our time away from school to help them fill any gaps that may exist.


In addition to these catch-up curriculum sessions, our pupils will continue to enjoy a range of enriching subjects such as Computing, Art, Design Technology and PE.


