



Pike Fold Primary School runs an incredibly successful Resource Provision (RP) known as the Arc. The Arc is a specialist resource provision that supports up to seven pupils with a diagnosis of autism or developmental language delay.

Our experienced team have supported a range of schools through our outreach offer, delivered training alongside the local authority and speak regularly at SENCO networks.

Our Outreach Team is led by a specialist teacher and qualified SENCO and supported by an experienced Th.INC Therapist.

The Pike Fold Outreach Team work with schools to develop inclusive practice and strategies to support specific pupils who have a diagnosis or are undergoing assessment for a diagnosis of autism.

Mission Statement

At Pike Fold we provide a safe, caring and happy environment where children develop skills which enable them to make choices which will impact positively on their lives.

Core Offer

Currently Pike Fold is not funded via the local authority for our outreach team. We offer this service because of our dedication to supporting local schools and developing best practice to support the children and young people in Manchester with SEND.

All schools are able to access 2 free hours of support per academic year from our outreach team.

Once these 2 hours have been completed schools will be able to commission additional time and support at a cost to your school.

Outreach Services

Our outreach team are currently able to provide the following support.:

- Telephone consultations with appropriate staff
- Pupil observations with verbal feedback and written support.
- Advice and guidance to developing inclusive environments.
- Strategies to support an effective transition between settings.
- Support in developing the use of visuals for specific pupils and making your whole school environment more inclusive.
- Support in developing inclusive timetabling for individual pupils.
- Strategies to develop positive individualised behavior systems.
- Resources to support individual learners.
- Visits to Pike Fold to experience how we have developed a whole school inclusive environment.

Collaborative Working

In order for any outreach support to be successful ;

- Please complete an outreach request form, these are accessible from our website or can be requested via email to the outreach team.
- Time to be made available to meet with staff supporting pupils before any observations. This will need to be a minimum of 30 minutes and must include the teacher.
- Time to be made available to meet with the staff supporting pupils to provide verbal feedback following observations. This will need to be a minimum of 30 minutes and must include the teacher.
- Appropriate access to paperwork from other professionals.
- Completed evaluation forms following our involvement to allow us to continue to develop our service.
